### **Do I need a permit to remove my tree(s)?**

A tree removal permit is required for any tree work to be carried out in Weston Florida.

Their tree preservation ordinance is in place to maintain the look and feel of Westons landscaped environment, and to encourage the development of the tree canopy throughout the city.

These cities tree canopy is protected by the permitting process of tree removal.

Please contact the City's Tree Preservation Code Administrator, Bill Tesauro at 954-266-6489 or via email to discuss the specific issue on your property.

All tree/palm trimming, removal, relocation, and root pruning not done by the homeowner themselves, must be done by a registered City of Weston tree service near you provider in accordance to City Code Chapter 122
